

Oda Nobunaga (織田 信長) 1534–1582 *Nakanunara, koroshiteshimae, hototogisu (If the cuckoo does not sing, kill it.)*

Toyotomi no Hideyoshi (豊臣 秀吉) 1536–1598 = Hiyoshi-maru 日吉丸 = Saru (monkey) = Kinoshita Tōkichirō = Hashiba Hideyoshi *Nakanunara, nakashitemiseyou, hototogisu (If the cuckoo does not sing, coax it.)*

Nene (ねね) 1546–1624 = Kōdai-in (高台院)

Tokugawa Ieyasu (徳川 家康) 1543–1616 *Nakanunara, nakumadematou, hototogisu (If the cuckoo does not sing, wait for it.)*

Yamauchi Kazutoyo (山内一豊) 1545–1605
